Weekend, holiday, and evening availability is required for these roles. We are recruiting people who are top performers with excellent time management and critical thinking skills and a fierce passion for serving the community.

Key responsibilities:

- Establishing a working interaction with homeless single adults in the bridge housing facility for the purpose of ensuring a supportive and safe environment.
- Working collaboratively with other team members to maintain a smooth operation of the bridge housing site, which may include assisting with food services or other duties.
- Intervening during crises to actively de-escalate situations, with client and team member safety in mind.
- Communicating repair requests to management when needed.
- Maintaining client confidentiality at all times, while following agency, state, and HIPAA laws.
- Creating incident reports, shift logs, and other documents required.
- Establishing and maintaining positive, productive working relationships with mental health professionals, local police departments and officials, and other providers of services and resources to homeless individuals.
- Attending staff meetings, case conferences, trainings and community meetings as required and completing other duties as assigned.
