Harbor Interfaith Services is looking to add a full time **Case Manager** to our team. This is a full-time role with a set schedule of Tuesday through Saturday, 9am to 6pm. We are recruiting people who are top performers with excellent interpersonal and critical thinking skills and a fierce passion for serving the community.

Key responsibilities:

- Completing a Vulnerability Index Service Prioritization and Decision Assistance Tool (VI-SPDAT) to determine vulnerability and acuity of homeless individuals at the shelter and directing referrals.
- Initiating contact and establishing a working interaction with the homeless population in the shelter for the purpose of providing assistance with attaining housing and access to needed services.
- Assisting in obtaining housing readiness documentation such as ID, social security card, and income verification.
- Assisting in completion of housing applications and accompanying individuals to housing appointments.
- Maintaining complete client records (including data entry and client files) daily activity logs, mileage logs, and other reports as directed.
- Establishing and maintain positive, productive working relationships with mental health programs, shelter programs, police (and other local officials), and providers of services and resources to homeless individuals.
- Attending staff meetings, case conferences, training workshops, and community meetings as needed and completing other duties as assigned.
